### CATHEDRAL ASSISTANT & GUIDES - Seasonal Fixed Term Contract

Saint Patrick's Cathedral has been at the centre of our history and culture for over 800 years. Dating from the 13th century and built in honour of Ireland's patron saint, Saint Patrick's is the National Cathedral of the Church of Ireland and is also one of Ireland's most popular tourist attractions. With over 600,000 visitors each year it is the third most visited admission-charging tourist attraction in Dublin city.

We have vacancies for **Cathedral Assistant & Guides** to provide support during our busy season which runs until October. Weekly working hours will total **40**, paid on the basis of €11.38 per hour. The role operates on a shift basis (*five over seven day roster*) between the hours of 08.00 and 20:00. Occasional additional hours will be required and in respect of which overtime will be paid.

#### MAIN DUTIES

- Ensuring a warm welcome to worshippers and visitors to the Cathedral;
- Being a welcoming presence to worshippers and visitors at the Cathedral gates while worship is in progress;
- Working at the Welcome Desks, duties include operating the till, welcoming visitors, managing visitor flow, handing out information leaflets and other related duties;
- Conducting guided tours of the Cathedral, gaining a good knowledge of the Cathedral and its history, and passing this on to visitors;
- Assisting Cathedral management in delivery of successful events including (but not limited to) services, concerts and graduation ceremonies;
- Other duties as directed by Cathedral management.

- A team player who is flexible and willing to work in different areas if required;
