STUART NICHOLSON

Master of the Music

Stuart Nicholson studied at the Royal College of Music in London with John Birch, during which time he was awarded scholarships at the Temple Church and Saint Paul's Cathedral; he became an Associate of the Royal College of Music in organ performance with honours and graduated with a first class honours in July 1997.

After graduating, Stuart spent 6 months as acting assistant organist of Saint Mary's Cathedral, Edinburgh followed by appointments at Waltham Abbey, Essex and Birmingham Cathedral.

In 2010, Stuart was appointed Master of the Music at Saint Patrick's Cathedral. The Cathedral Choir maintains a far busier schedule (most of the time!) than most of their UK counterparts which includes 12 weekly choral services, frequent broadcasts, concerts, tours & recordings. A keen arranger, Stuart has had many of his arrangements published by Novello and performed by groups including the BBC Singers, the Bach Choir & the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra.

He lives in Dublin with wife Victoria and their 21-month old daughter Charlotte who certainly has the lung capacity to join her father in the choir stalls before too long!
